PORTS OF CALL

Glacier Bay National Park & Hubbard Glacier: Just west of Juneau, this breathtaking national park and preserve boasts some of the world's most spectacular tidewater glaciers, such as Margerie Glacier, which often drops colossal chunks of ice into the sea. Take in the awe-inspiring scenery as you enjoy an unforgettable day of sailing through this dazzling park, where you'll glide along emerald waters and past calving icebergs, and can breathe in the crisp, fresh air to your heart's content.

Skagway: Skagway was the gateway to the gold fields for the thousands who flocked to Alaska and the Yukon with the hope of striking it rich. Skagway may have boasted the shortest route to the Klondike but it wasn't the easiest. The gold rush was a boon and by 1898, Skagway was Alaska's largest town with a population of about 20,000. Today, Skagway has less than 1,000 residents but it still retains the flavor of the gold rush era.

Juneau: In 1880, it was slow going for Joe Juneau & Richard Harris as they searched for gold with the help of Native guides. After climbing mountains, forging streams & facing countless difficulties, they found nuggets "as large as beans." Today Juneau is famous not only for gold and government but also for its breathtakingly beautiful glaciers and stunning views of both water and mountains.

Ketchikan: Visitors to Ketchikan will be intrigued by its rich Native heritage, which includes the world's oldest collection of totem poles at Totem Heritage Center. The Haida, Tlingit & Tsimshian are all a part of the city's colorful history. Ketchikan, with its abundance of salmon, is also a sportfishing paradise. Sightseers will be impressed with both the scenic town & its surroundings, especially Misty Fjords National Monument.

Participant Agreement

By submitting a Registration Form and deposit for any Bus America Overnight Tour, individuals agree to be bound by the terms and conditions of participation and cancellation as indicated below. Any individual tour may have additional terms and/or conditions that apply and will be indicated on the specific tour flyer - travelers should review all tour documentation thoroughly prior to registering. Tours will be operated in accordance with all public health requirements and guidelines in place for the particular location/s at the time of the tour. These may include, but are not limited to requirements for face coverings, social distancing and venue or vehicle capacity limitations, submitting Covid-19 Waivers and health screening information, and/or other measures. All participants will be required to cooperate with any such requirements. If a tour is not able to be operated safely, Bus America will reschedule the tour for a future date and travelers will have a choice to participate on the rescheduled dates or receive a refund.

<u>Price/Group Size:</u> Overnight tour prices are based on a minimum group size of 25 travelers. If tour enrollments do not reach the required minimum group size, Bus America will offer the travelers the option to transfer their registration to another tour or receive a full refund.

Reservation and Payment Schedule: Reservations will be confirmed when a completed Overnight Tour Application form is submitted with the tour deposit or payment as indicated on the tour flyer. Registrations are accepted by mail, by phone, or online – see tour flyer for instructions and details. Generally, full payment for air/cruise tours are due 120-60 days prior to departure, however, each tour flyer will indicate the due dates for deposits and balances based on specific vendor contract requirements.

<u>Tour Schedule:</u> Prior to departure, Bus America will notify travelers if any changes are necessary to the pick-up, return, or activity time schedule that is indicated on the initial tour flyer. Our tour personnel will always do their best to adhere to the original time schedule as planned, however, cannot be held responsible for deviations or tardiness caused by unforeseen factors such as weather, traffic, etc.
